Fiscal 2002 District of Columbia Appropriations - Conference Report

Adoption of the conference report on the bill that would provide \$408 million for the District of Columbia in fiscal 2002, including funds for the city's courts and corrections systems. It would allocate \$16 million for the District to establish an emergency response plan in the wake of the Sept. 11 terrorist attacks. The agreement would allow the District to use local funds to carry out a city health plan offering coverage to the unmarried domestic partners of employees. It also would approve a \$7.15 billion budget for the District. The District would not be allowed to use local or federal funds for needle exchange programs.
