## Campaign Finance Overhaul - Passage

**April 2, 2001**

**Senate Roll Call Vote 64**

[S 27](#)

Passage of the bill that would ban soft money donations to political parties, prohibit corporate and union general treasury funds from being spent on issue ads, and require disclosure of individuals who pay for issue ads that run within 60 days of a general election or 30 days of a primary. It also would prevent certain issue ads from targeting specific candidates within the 60-day and 30-day periods. The bill, as amended, would increase the individual contribution limit per candidate to \$2,000 per election, the individual limit to national parties to \$25,000 per year and the individual aggregate limit to \$37,500 per year.

**Passed** by a vote of 59-41:

Republicans 12-38

Democrats 47-3 (Northern Democrats 40-1, Southern Democrats 7-2)
