

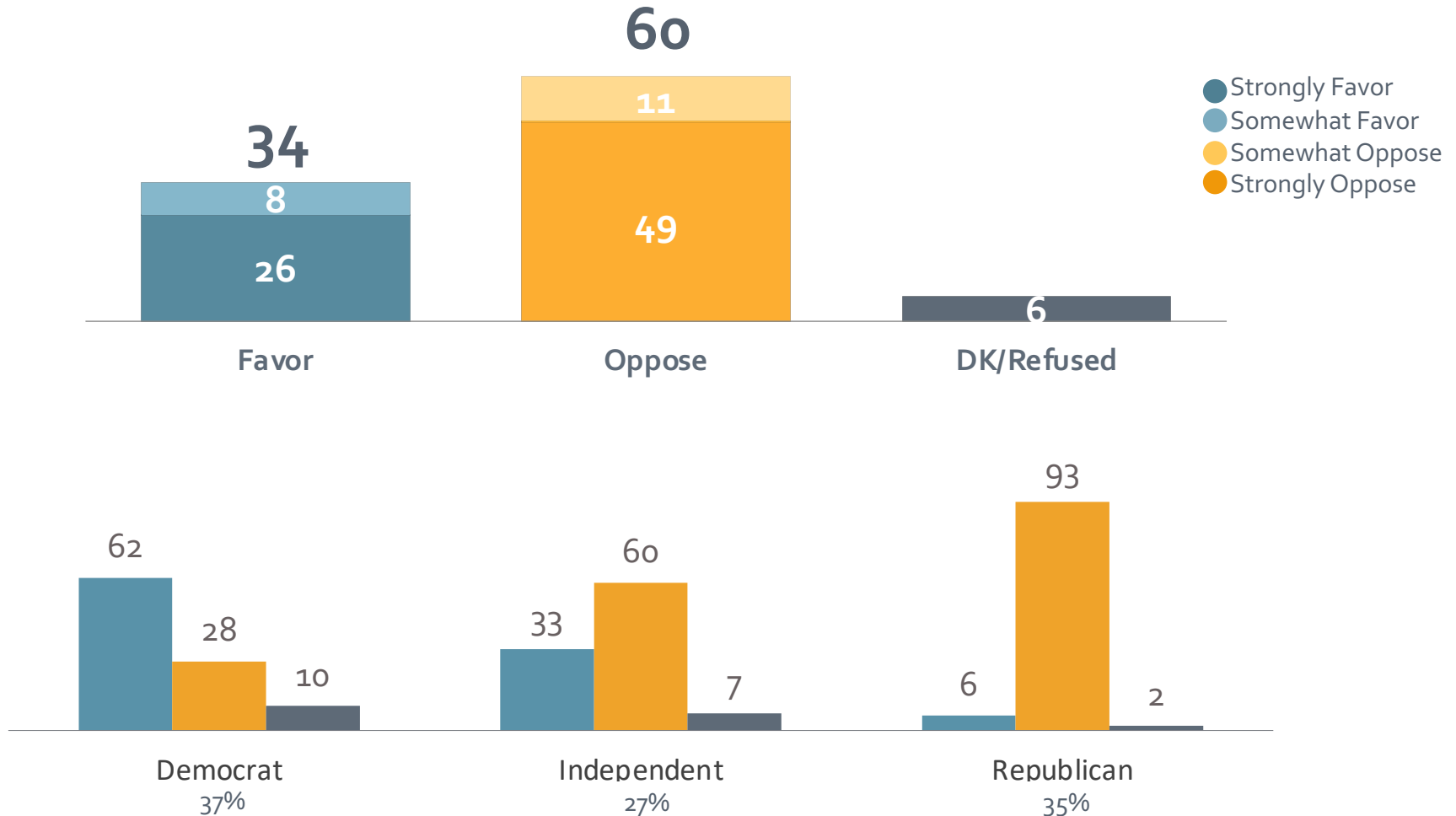

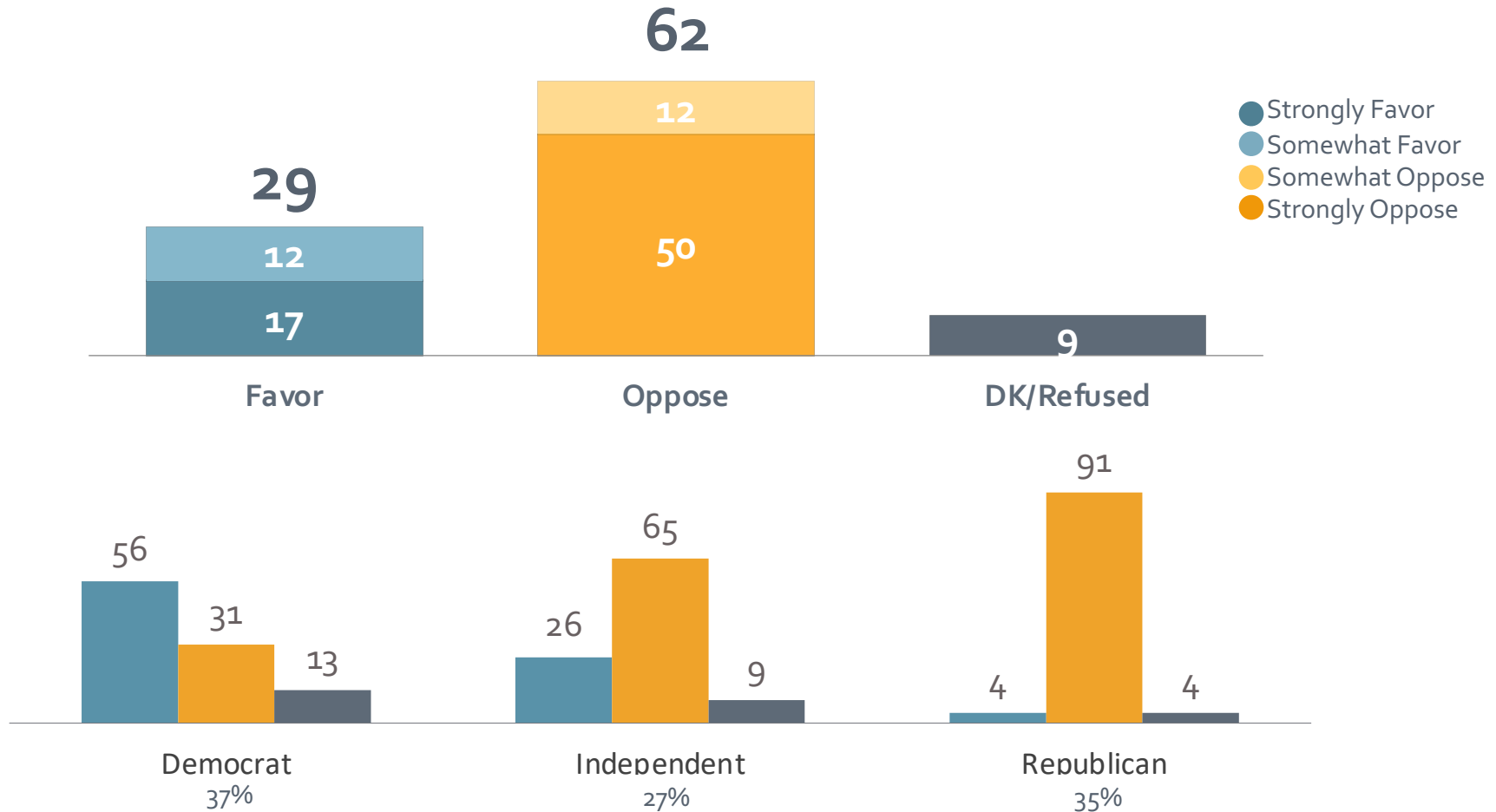
Biden Executive Order: Keystone Pipeline

An executive order ending construction of the Keystone XL pipeline eliminating over 10,000 well-paying jobs



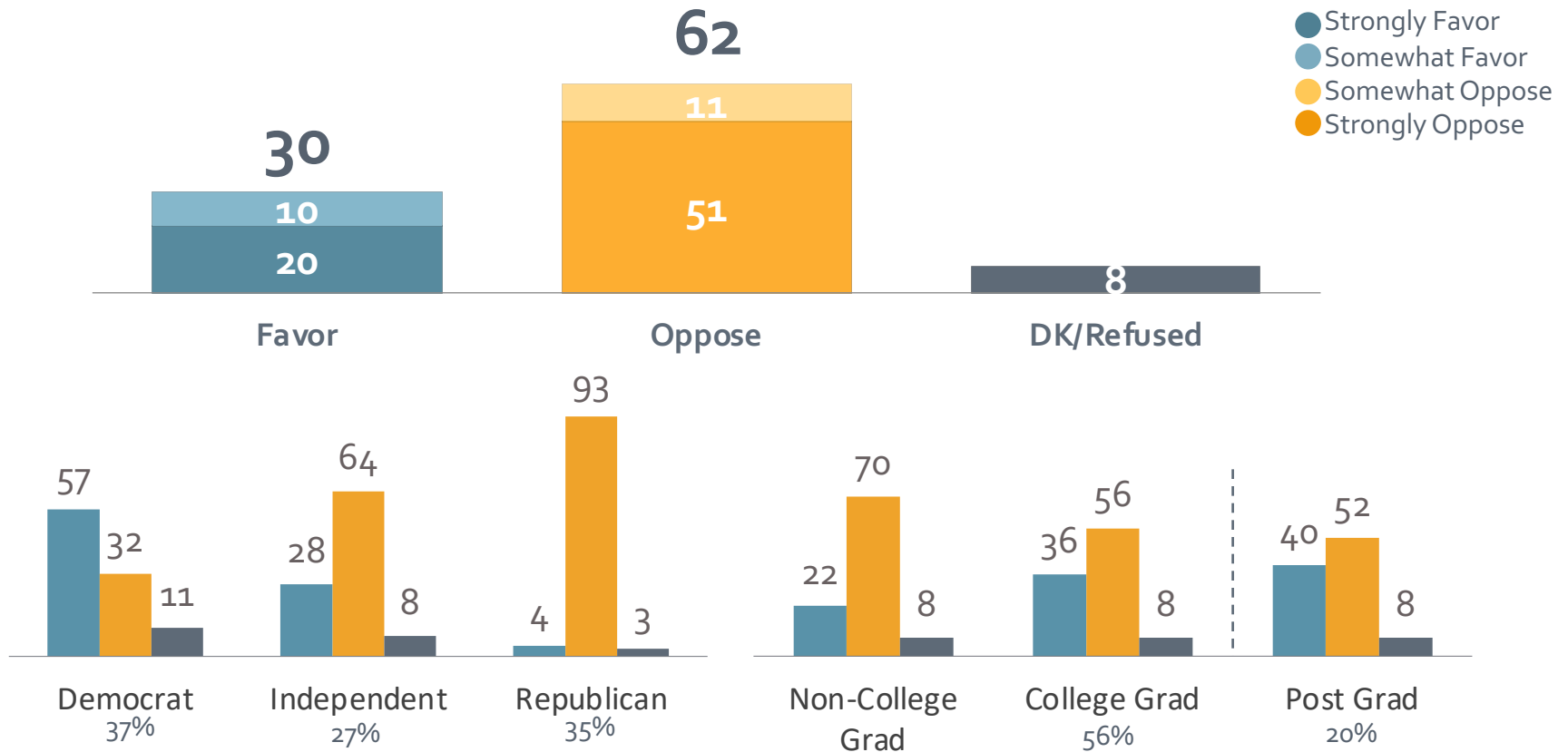
Fracking Ban

A nationwide ban on fracking which will cost over 100,000 jobs and significant raise energy costs



Biden Plan: Close Oil, Gas & Coal Industries

A plan to completely close the oil, gas and coal industries by 2050, which would dramatically raise transportation and energy costs, ending America's energy independence



Key Messaging

Intensity of Opposition to Job- Killing Policies

Not only do 6 in 10 American voters oppose the Democrats' job-killing energy policies; half of Americans indicate they are "strongly opposed" to shutting down the Keystone pipeline, fracking and the entire energy industry.

Democrats Held Hostage by Their Out of Touch Base

While the majority of Democratic voters support these radical energy policies, they are completely out of step with the clear center-right coalition that supports energy independence, low energy costs and more energy jobs.

Where Democrat Senators and Candidates Stand
