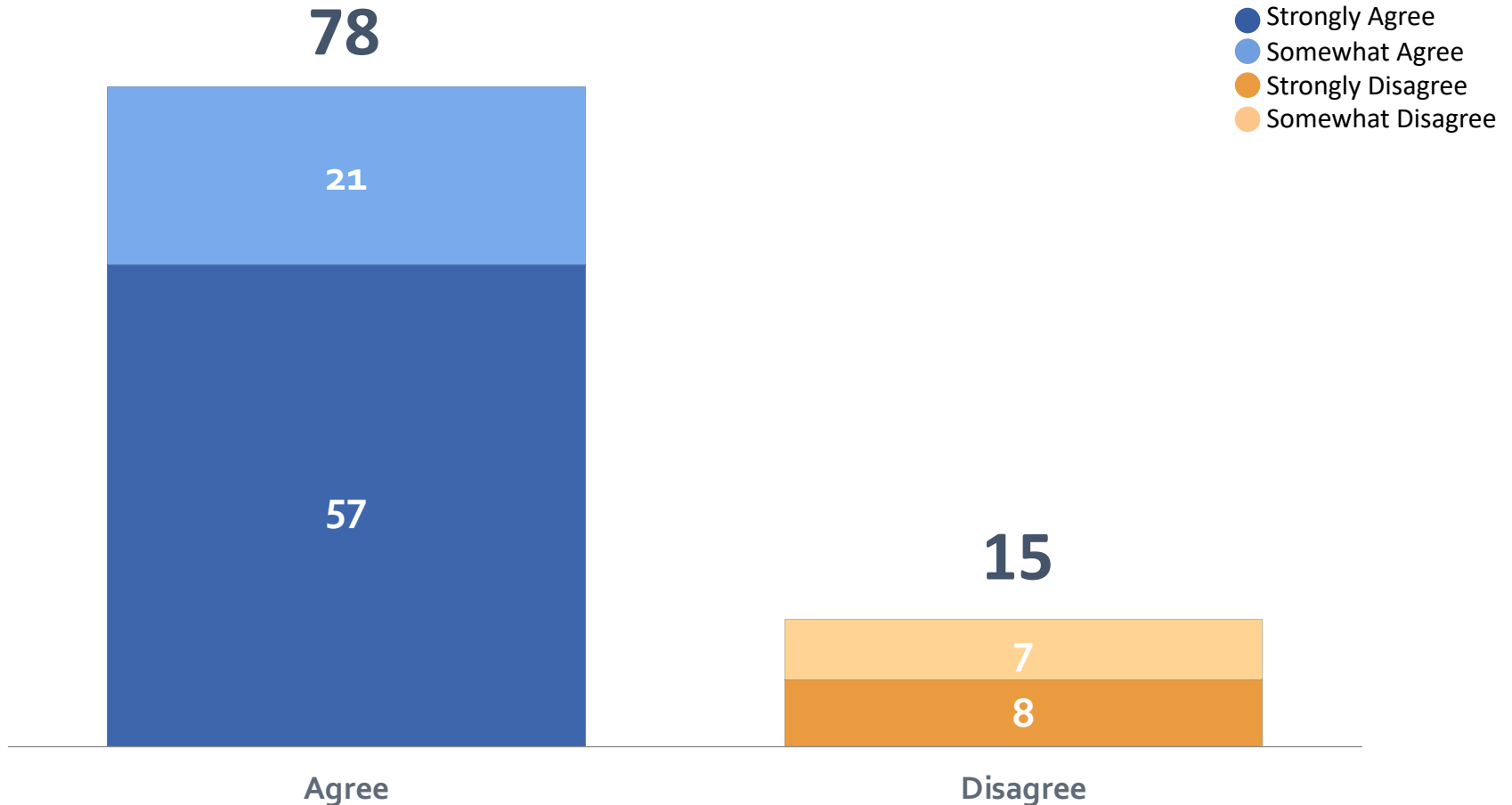

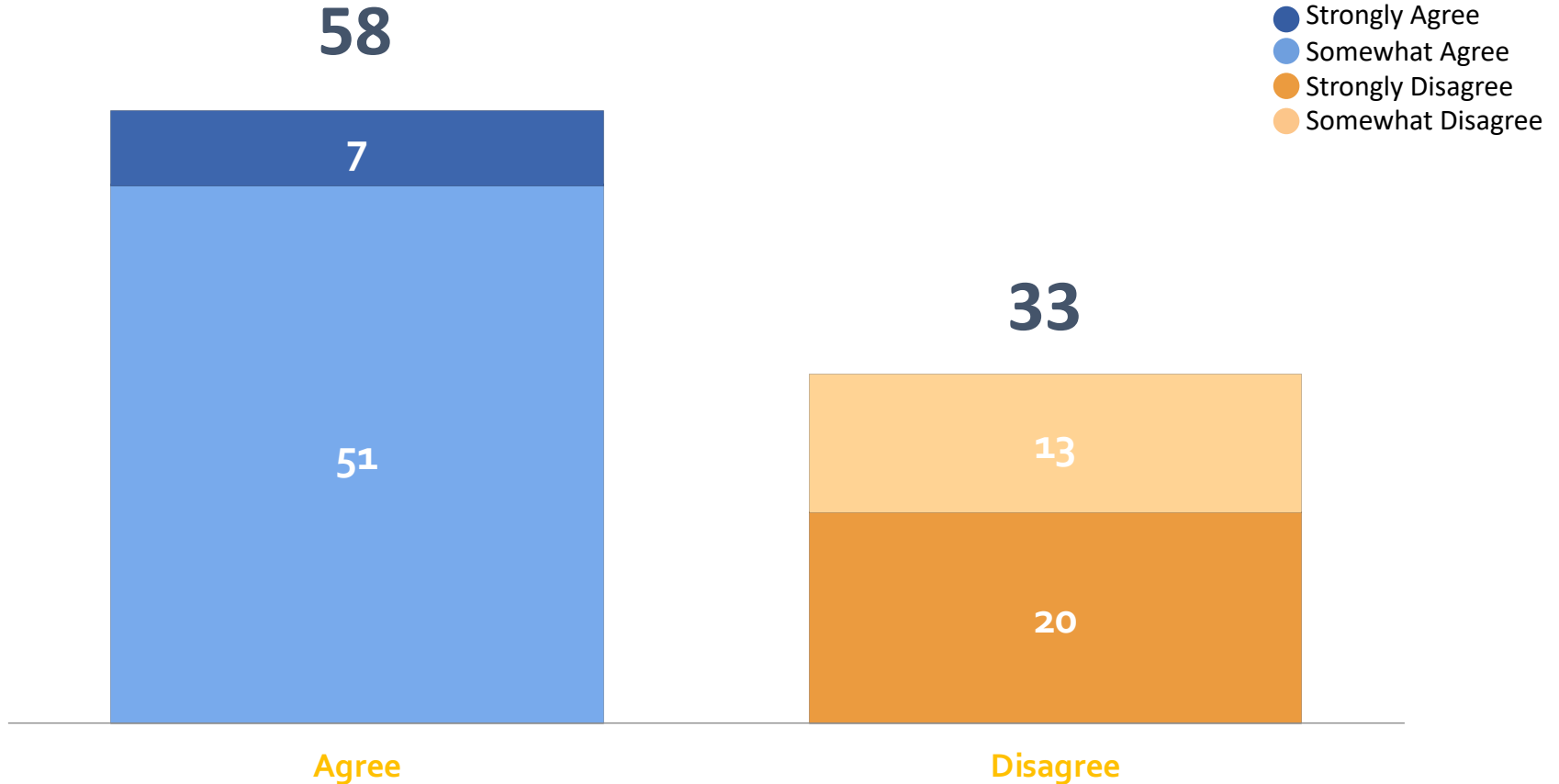

Critical Race Theory in Schools

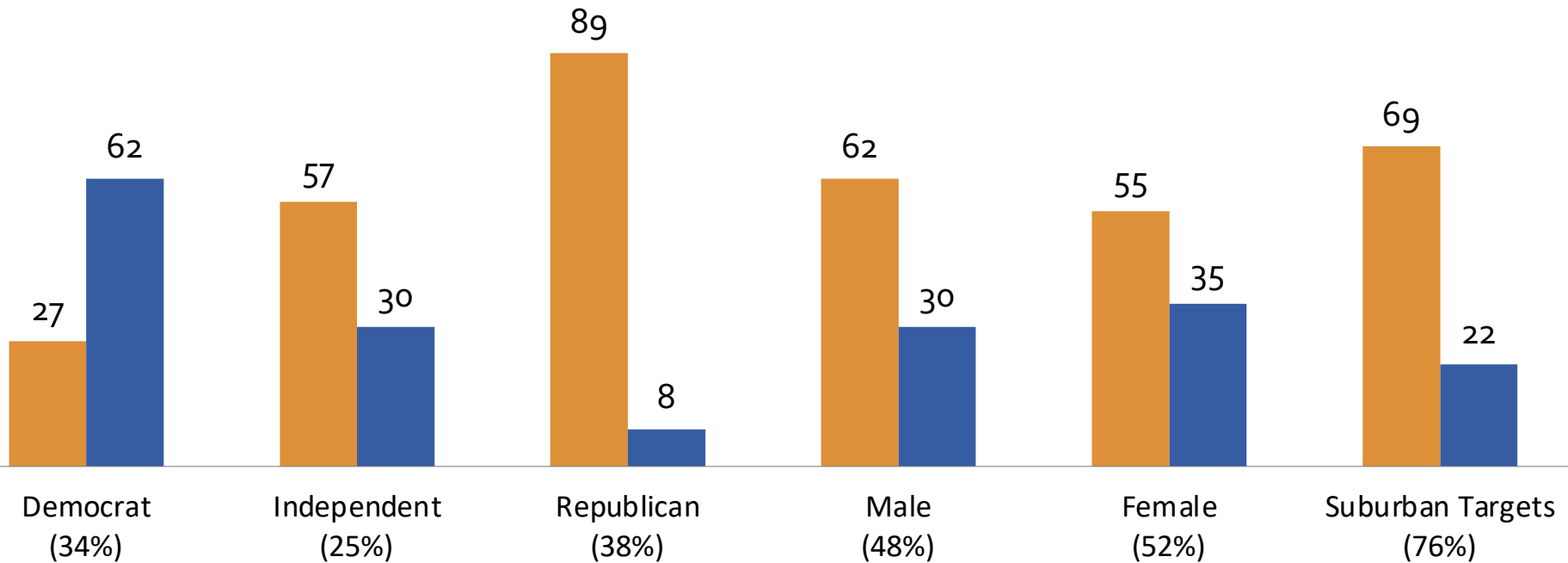

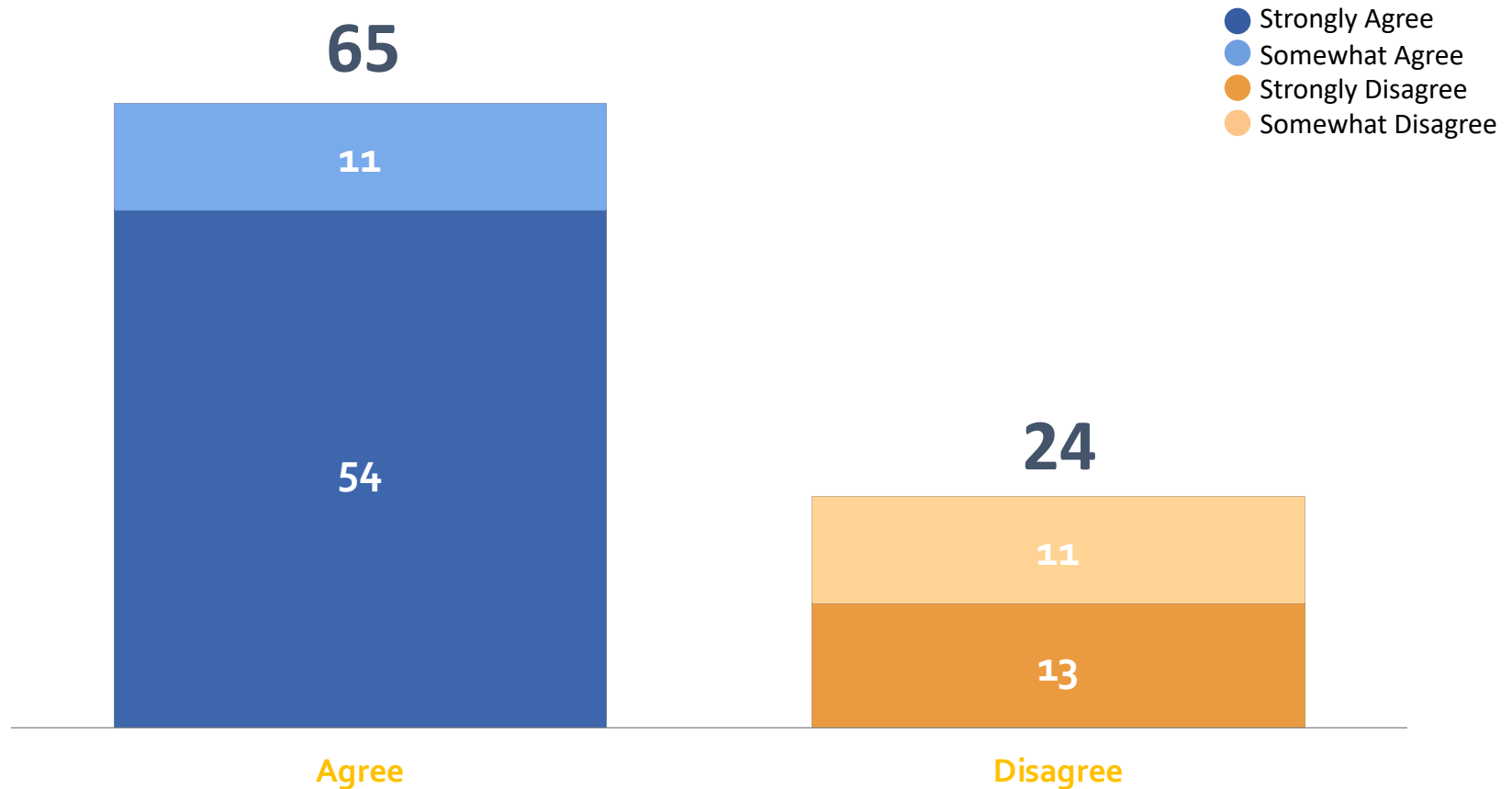

Biological Males in Women's Sports

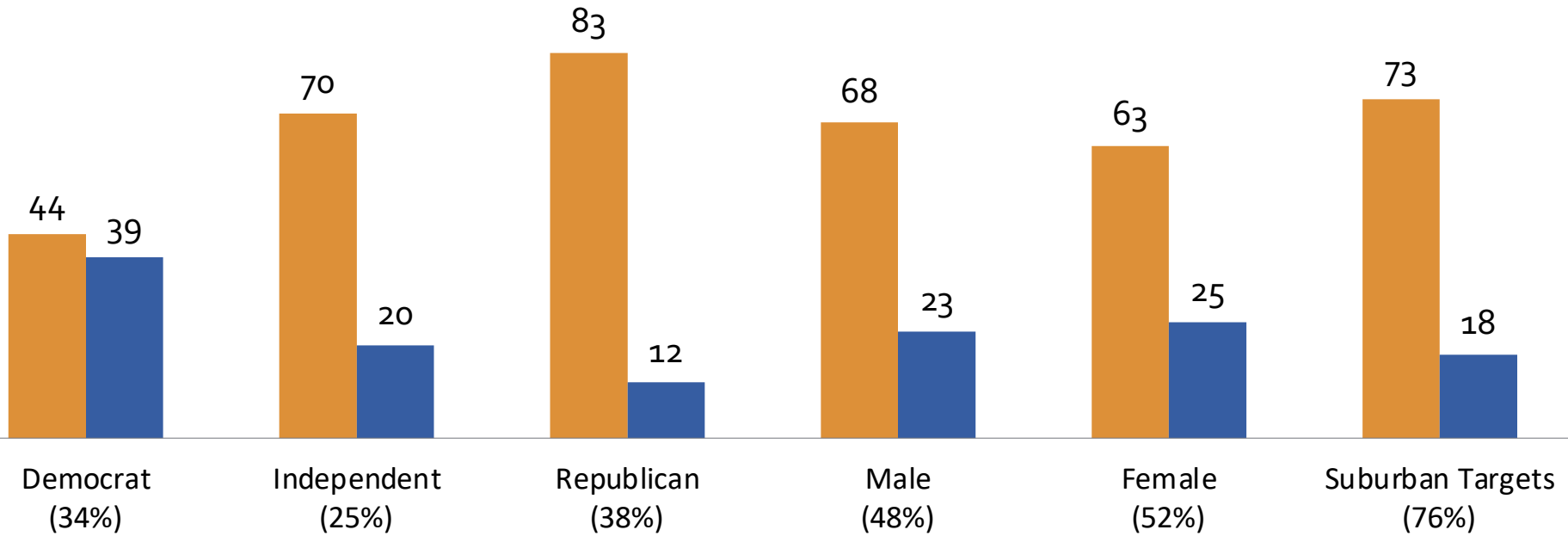

Suburban America Overwhelmingly Views Public Schools As Failing Students

Nearly four out of every five suburban voters in battleground states say public schools in America are failing children, a strong rebuke of a system that institutes many Democrat policies.
